Safe, Non-toxic, Bite Resistant and No Wires

Non-toxic, environmentally friendly Thermapol gel compound inside the solid pad retains heat for up to 10 hours! The hard pad offers bite resistance, and there's no need to worry about the risk of fire as the Snugglesafe Pad contains no wires at all, so you can rest easy leaving your pets at home alone with the heat pad, or even in an outdoor kennel or bed.

Perfect size

Measures approximately 22cm in diameter and will radiate beneath your pet's bedding. Its size also allows pets to move around and self-regulate their body warmth if they get too hot or too cold.

Bonus Fleecy Cover (Extra Covers can be purchased separately)

Fun paw-print fleece cover keeps your pet's skin away from the heated pad for extra protection - stays on with Velcro.

Use with or without its fleece cover

Even when you wash the cover, you can place the pad under your pet's favourite bedding.

What pets need a heat pad?

Pets with illnesses such as diabetes, heart disease, kidney disease, or hormonal imbalances (e.g Cushing's disease) may have a harder time regulating their body temperature, making them more susceptible to problems from temperature extremes. The same goes for very young and very old pets.

Very young, arthritic or elderly pets

Arthritic and elderly pets feel the cold even more, making it harder for them to walk and move around. Pets that are suffering from arthritis or physical injury will receive comfort from a heated surface. A dog or cat with arthritis should be able to move the injured joint better when the affected area is kept warm.

Pets who like to be outside

Just like you, pets prefer comfortable sleeping places and may change their location based on their need for more or less warmth. Give them some safe options to allow them to vary their sleeping place to adjust to their needs. Snugglesafe's size means that your pet can move around to control their temperature.

Safety

Puppies and kittens find it hard to self-regulate their temperature, so always keep an eye on them, especially when using a heat pad.
